

SCORING FOR THE 2008-09 CLUB ACTION RANKING CHART

1. A one time per new member twenty (20) point credit for every new member added to your roster on record with Kiwanis International.
2. In every month where a club is showing a net membership gain, ten (10) points will be awarded.
3. Fifty (50) points for sponsoring a new Kiwanis Club and twenty-five (25) points for the sponsorship of a new, Circle K Club, Key Club, Builders Club, Aktion Club or K-Kids Club.
4. Five points per member(s), per day that participate(s) in recruiting for a new club with a maximum of 30 points per month. Trustee for Region has final say on points and participation.
5. Attendance: Maximum of twenty (20) points awarded based on your percentage of attendance.

Example: Club has 85% attendance in a month
 $20 \times .85 = 17$
Club receives 17 points

6. Interclub: Club receives five (5) points for each Interclub 35 miles and under (one way) up to a maximum of two per month. Club receives ten (10) points for each interclub over 35 miles (one way) up to a maximum of two per month.
7. Club Services: Club receives twenty (20) points for reporting a donation of money (or an equivalent gift) of less than \$ 500.00 in one of four areas (Community services, Spiritual Aims, Youth Services and Young Children-Priority One); monetary donations (or an equivalent gift) of \$ 500.00 or more will be awarded 30 points. Monthly donations to one organization will be awarded points based on that month's contribution, not the cumulative total of the gift.
If a club reports an actual "hands on" service project in one of the four service areas, twenty (20) points will be awarded, if less than three (3) Kiwanians are involved in the project. If three (3) or more Kiwanians are involved, thirty points (30) will be awarded.
Please note that two (2) twenty (20) or thirty (30) point credits may be earned in the Community Services area only for a possible total 40 to 60 points. Only one twenty or thirty point award per month given in each of the other areas.
Activity must be external to the club and cannot benefit club members only; for example, invocation at each meeting does not get a club credit in the area of Spiritual Aims. Generally, planning an activity does not get credit; however, depending on the intensity of the planning and how it is reported, some exceptions will be made and credit will be given.
8. Sponsored Youth: Ten (10) points awarded for each Circle K Club, Key Club, Builders Club, Aktion Club and K-Kids Club a Kiwanis Club sponsors and reports. However if the sponsored club(s) have not met their District and International obligations, then no credit will be awarded to the Kiwanis Club until such time as those obligations are met. Twenty (20) bonus points can be earned if the Kiwanis Club conducts and reports joint service and fund-raising activities with any or all of its sponsored youth clubs and at least three (3) Kiwanians participate in this joint effort. This is a 20 point maximum bonus per month regardless of the number of projects and the number of sponsored youth groups involved.
9. Administrative Activities:
 - A. Publicity: Ten points awarded if club reports external publicity.
 - B. Programs: Ten (10) points awarded if the club reports a program at any of its meetings in a month.
 - C. Bulletin: Ten (10) points awarded if club reports publication of a bulletin during the month.
 - D. Submit Report: Fifteen (20) points awarded for reports postmarked by the 10th of the month they are due. Two (2) points are taken off for each business day the report is postmarked after the 10th.
